

## MoneyGram Privacy Notice for California Residents

<b>Purpose</b>	<p>This <b>Privacy Notice for California Residents</b> (“<b>Notice</b>”) supplements the information contained in MoneyGram’s <a href="#">Global Privacy Notice</a> and applies to all visitors, users, and others who reside in the State of California (“<b>consumers</b>” or “<b>you</b>”). We adopt this Notice to comply with the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 (“<b>CCPA</b>”) and any terms used but not defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the CCPA.</p>

<b>Scope</b>	<p>The specific Personal Information that we collect, use, and disclose relating to a California resident covered by the CCPA will vary based on our relationship or interaction with that individual. This means that even though the CCPA generally applies to Personal Information that identifies, relates to, or could reasonably be linked with a particular California resident, it may not apply to certain Personal Information that is subject to certain sector-specific privacy laws. This means, for example, Personal Information that is subject to more restrictive privacy laws, such as the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (“<b>GLBA</b>”), or MoneyGram collects and uses as a provider of money transfer services and products that is subject to GLBA, will not be subject to CCPA. ### CATEGORIES OF SOURCES

We obtain the categories of Personal Information listed above from the following categories of sources:

- **Directly from you.** For example, from forms you complete, through customer support interactions when you provide the information to us, when you complete online forms or register for our loyalty and reward programs.
- **Indirectly from you.** For example, when you visit our Website through cookies or similar technologies described in our [Cookie Policy](#).
- **Other source of categories:** For example, service providers, vendors and other third parties; public record sources (federal, state or local government sources); information from our affiliates and subsidiaries; our Website, Mobile App activities and Social Media Networks; information from our partners or agents about individuals associated with them (e.g., an employee or owner).

### HOW WE USE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may use or disclose the Personal Information we collect for one or more of the following purposes:

- To fulfill or meet the reason you provided the information.
- To provide, support, personalize, and develop our Website, products, and services.
- To create, maintain, customize, and secure your profile with us.
- To process your requests, transactions, and payments and prevent transactional fraud. To provide you with support and to respond to your inquiries, including to investigate and address your concerns and monitor and improve our responses.
- To personalize your Website experience and to deliver content and product and service offerings relevant to your interests, including targeted offers and ads through our Website, third-party sites, and via email or text message (with your consent, where required by law).

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To help verify or maintain the quality, safety, security, and integrity of our Website, products and services, databases and other technology assets, and business as well as to improve, upgrade, or enhance same.</li> <li>• To detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activities, and prosecute those responsible for that activity.</li> <li>• For testing, research, analysis, and product development, including to develop and improve our Website, products, and services.</li> <li>• To debug, to identify and repair errors that impair our systems and platforms.</li> <li>• To comply with laws and regulations and respond to law enforcement requests and as required by applicable law, court order, or governmental regulations.</li> <li>• To evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets.</li> <li>• As described to you when collecting your Personal Information or as otherwise set forth in the CCPA.</li> </ul> <p>We will not use the Personal Information we collect for materially different, unrelated, or incompatible purposes without providing you notice.</p>
<p><b>CATEGORIES OF THIRD PARTIES WE SHARE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION</b></p>	<p>In the prior 12 months, we may have shared your Personal Information to the following categories of third parties for our legitimate business purposes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Our affiliates and subsidiaries;</li> <li>• Service providers and/or vendors;</li> <li>• Our agents and business partners;</li> <li>• Governmental entities such as law enforcement agencies;</li> <li>• Advertising and social networks;</li> <li>• Internet service providers; and</li> <li>• Data analytics providers.</li> </ul> <p>When we disclose Personal Information for a business purpose, we enter a contract that describes the purpose and requires the recipient to both keep that Personal Information confidential and not use it for any purpose except for performing the contract.</p>
<p><b>SALE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION</b></p>	<p>In the preceding 12 months, we have not sold Personal Information subject to CCPA, including Personal Information of minors under the age of sixteen (<b>16</b>). For the purposes of this Notice, “sold” means the disclosure of Personal Information to a third party for monetary or other valuable consideration.</p>
<p><b>YOUR RIGHTS AND CHOICES UNDER CCPA</b></p>	<p>The CCPA provides consumers who are California residents with specific rights regarding their Personal Information. This section describes your CCPA rights and explains how to exercise those rights.</p>

### **(1) Access to Specific Information and Data Portability Rights**

You have the right to request that we disclose certain information to you about our collection and use of your Personal Information over the past 12 months. Once we receive and confirm your verifiable consumer request, to the extent allowed by law, we will disclose to you:

- The categories of Personal Information we collected about you.
- The categories of sources for the Personal Information we collected about you.
- Our business or commercial purpose for collecting your Personal Information.
- The categories of third parties with whom we share your Personal Information.
- The specific pieces of Personal Information we collected about you.

### **(2) Deletion Request Rights**

You have the right to request that we delete any of your Personal Information that we collected from you and retained, subject to certain exceptions. Once we receive and confirm your verifiable consumer request, we will delete (and direct our service providers to delete) your Personal Information from our records, unless an exception applies. For example, we will not honor your request where we need the Personal Information to comply with a legal obligation; there are internal and lawful uses of that information that are compatible with the context in which you provided it; the disclosure of Personal Information would adversely affect the rights and freedoms of another consumer; or where the Personal Information that we maintain about you is not subject to the CCPA's access or deletion rights.

If you are a California resident, to exercise the access, data portability, and deletion rights described above, you may submit a verifiable consumer request to us by either:

### **HOW TO EXERCISE YOUR RIGHTS**

Only you, or someone legally authorized to act on your behalf, may make a verifiable consumer request related to your Personal Information. You may only make a verifiable consumer request for access or data portability twice within a 12-month period.

We cannot respond to your request or provide you with Personal Information if we cannot verify your identity or authority to make the request and confirm the Personal Information relates to you.

We endeavor to respond to a verifiable consumer request within forty-five (45) days of its receipt. If we require more time, we will inform you of the reason and extension period in writing.

Any disclosures we provide will only cover the 12-month period preceding the verifiable consumer request's receipt. The response we provide will also explain the reasons we cannot comply with a request, if applicable.

We reserve the right to amend this Notice at our discretion at any time. When we make changes to this Notice, we will post the updated Notice on our Website and update the Notice's effective date. **Your continued use of our Website following the posting of changes constitutes your acceptance of such changes.**
